# Grad Night Countdown has begun! Don't be left off the bus!!! Sign-Up Deadline is May 25

**What is Grad Night?** Grad Night is a safe, sober and fun tradition for all M-A graduating seniors. Everything is provided, including food, drink, transportation, and entertainment! The kids will meet at the M-A Gym at 7:30 p.m. <u>sharp</u> on graduation night (June 4) and be taken by bus to a surprise location. They will return to M-A by 3:00 a.m. (the next morning).

Will we be able to have a family dinner before the Grad Night Party? There will be little time between the end of the graduation ceremony (6:00 p.m.) and check-in time for Grad Night (7:30 p.m.). Please plan your family celebrations accordingly!

Is it really safe to let my graduate party until 3:00 a.m.? Yes, if it is the M-A Grad Night party! The graduates will be transported by bus, and there will be adult chaperones and security with them throughout the night. This is a PTA-sponsored Safe & Sober event.

What happens at the party? The location is secret, and the entertainment is secret. But here is what we can tell you: It's going to be a BLAST and there will be non-stop entertainment for every type of personality, as well as lots of music and food!

Why is Grad Night special? For many seniors, this will be the first time that they have had a chance to party together. And for many, this will be the last time. But no matter their backgrounds or their futures, they will be bonded forever as the M-A Class of 2020. Grad Night will be their last high school event - an opportunity for them to celebrate their shared accomplishment.
